RECEPTION




This half term Reception enjoyed going on a community bus trip to explore our local area and talk about the key features of our community.

KS1

In Maths the children have been developing their skills learning place value, addition and subtraction.



This term the children in KS1 the children have been learning about the seasons and the weather. They enjoyed discovering the wind direction on the playground.





KS1 have discussed facts about different types of animals. We discussed, fish, birds, amphibians, mammals, reptiles and insects. The children have learnt the lifecycle of a frog. They discussed terms like frog, froglet, frogspawn and tadpole, they were able to show their understanding by ordering and labelling the lifecycle.

This half term the children have been reading 'The Creakers' by Tom Fletcher. We created our own instructions on 'How to catch a 'Creaker' and worked on our own character and setting descriptions based around the book. LKS2 have really enjoyed reading The Creakers and their next class read will be Varjak Paw

In R.E LKS2 have been learning about the humanism world view this term and we looked at spirituality and what people believe a soul is. We enjoyed Buddhist meditation and will continue to practice meditation throughout the year to help keep us calm.

Our activity day was amazing! The children especially loved the climbing wall and took part in all the activities.





UKS2

UKS2 were very lucky to have author Marie Basting come to school to talk to them all about her new book 'Auntie Medusa and Me'. They began by learning a bit about Marie and how she became an author, then they played a game called 'Truth or Porky Pie' where they had to say whether Greco-Roman facts were true or false (some of them were disgusting!). Then the children got up to mischief – like the characters in her stories – and made the teachers do different dances. Finally, some of the children bought Marie's book and had it signed by her right there and then!



This term UKS2 delved straight into their Ancient Greeks topic and explored lots of different stories from this culture, including Theseus & The Minotaur, Hercules, and Perseus & Medusa. They read a variety of different texts and used the books in the classroom, before getting together in groups and selecting a scene from a myth to perform to the rest of the class.

Some of the year 6 pupils were lucky enough to go and visit the residents at Oakmere Residential Home in Handforth and make poppy wreaths together. The Wreaths will form part of the remembrance parade in Handforth.



Rainbow Room

The RP's topic this half term has been 'Our World'. The children have been learning about our world through maps, sensory play, food, music, architecture and animals.
